

ClearBrook FFA Booster Club Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, February 16, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. The secretary, Dorothy See, read the minutes. Denise Christensen motioned to accept the minutes with corrections ; and John Valenti seconded the motion. Cheryl Hampton thanked everyone that helped with the Project Show Concession Stand. She also thanked everyone that donated items for the stand. Many drinks were left; and they will be used for future events.

The Booster Club will not have to reimburse Vicky Bland or Bill Carraway for expenses incurred at the San Antonio Livestock Show. Vicky Bland did not go as female chaperone. Ms. Malone went instead. Mr. Carraway drove his truck; but he did not transport the heifers. Cheryl Hampton told us about a meeting that was held earlier in February that decided that each FFA Booster Club in the district give \$100.00 to purchase an ad to thank the buyers of the CCISD Project Show. Our treasurer, Kelly Seylar, will take care of this transaction.

Cheryl Hampton, our president, also said we do not have a second pit for the brisket cook. Mr. Dickson said that Mr. Stokley, the ClearCreek FFA teacher, has volunteered to smoke our briskets. We have decided to table the discussion of the brisket cook until the March meeting

Mr. Dickson then discussed Chapter News. The students that sold their animals at the CCISD Project Show need to write thank-you notes to their buyers. Thank-you notes also need to be written if you had an add-on. The deadline for the notes is April 15, 2010. The FFA Judging trip is going to cost each student \$235.00. Mr. Dickson has asked the Booster Club if they might pay some of the cost of each child's trip. The expense includes a charter bus and Hotel accomendations for 4 days. The Booster Club voted. Shelly Tamas motioned to give \$35.00 to each student for the trip; and John Valenti seconded the motion. The student's money needs to be in by March 1, 2010. Mr. Dickson would like the ClearBrook FFA parents to create a Buyer's group so we can buy our students' animals at the CCISD Project Show. National FFA week is February 22-26, 2010. Our students may need to bring food for all the ClearBrook teachers. The students will serve the food in the morning before class. The FFA students are selling programs at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo; and also selling \$1.00 lollipops at school to raise money for their chapter.

The updated Treasurer's report was read by our treasurer, Kelly Seylar. Our ending balance for this month is \$7,498.50. The club made \$1,146.00 at the CCISD Project Show Concession stand. Our next booster club meeting is scheduled for March 30, 2010. The Scholarship Committee and Officer selection will be done when we meet in April. The ClearBrook FFA banquet is May 18, 2010. Denise Christensen motioned to adjourn the meeting and Jeanie Engle seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 7:43p.m.
