

Clear Brook FFA Booster Club Meeting Minutes

We still have drinks left for our next concession stand. Two boxes of sausage on a stick went bad in the Ag building; because the electricity went out. We had to throw them out. On November 5, we have to work the CCISD Football Concession Stand. Cheryl Hampton, our president, says we need to be there by 6:00p.m. with a cap. We also need at least 22 people in order to receive our \$600.00. We get in free; and also get free parking.
