

Clear Brook FFA Booster Club Meeting Minutes

For: November 10, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m. after a quorum was established. The secretary, Dorothy See, read the minutes from the October meeting. J.T. Hampton motioned to accept the minutes; and Denise Christensen and John Valenti seconded the motion. The minutes were accepted as is. The Treasurer, Kelly Seylar, read the treasury report. The balance is \$5,022.98. Jeanie Engle motioned to accept the report and John Valenti seconded the motion. The treasurer report was accepted with date change. Parents of FFA students need to sign school permission form in for their student to have their picture taken and to be on the FFA Web site. Mr. Dickson needs to give our historian, Sue Bingham, the permission slips before she can photograph each student. The Concession stand had 25 volunteers. Thanks everyone for your help; and it was fun.

The brisket cook is scheduled for Friday, November 13, 2009 at Darrin's and Sue's Bingham house. Cheryl Hampton ordered 95 briskets. We sold 93, but are cooking a few additional ones. Denise Christensen made a motion for the booster club to pay for oak or mesquite for the pits; if we do not get a donation for the wood. J.T. Hampton seconded that motion. A sign-up sheet was passed around to our members so they could donate items for the mop sauce for the briskets. J.T. Hampton says we need to start by 6:00 p.m. The process will take awhile. Cheryl Hampton passed around a sign-up for parents to volunteer for the brisket cook. The cook will take all night.

The CCISD Project Show is at the end of January. We think just Clear Springs and Clear Brook are working the concession stand. Last year we drew days. Clear Brook got two days of the show and Clear Springs got the other two. Each club needs to give \$50.00 to pay for the drinks for the buyers for the auction. It is Clear Brook's turn to get the health certificate, Kelly Seylar has volunteered to take charge of the concession stand this year. She will need many volunteers. The Progress Show is December 12, 2009 from 1 p.m. to 6.m. The show will consist of only three schools. The schools involved are Clear Brook, Clear Lake, and Clear View. It will be a showmanship show only.

Mr. Dickson discussed Chapter News. He talked about the dates for pick-up of the students that paid for chickens, turkeys, and rabbits. He urged parents to encourage their children, especially seniors to enter the Galveston County Show; because of possible scholarship opportunities. He also informed the club that the second nine weeks grade is what decides who will participate in the CCISD Project. If on January 15, 2010, your student fails; their animal will need to immediately removed from the school barn. On January 23 and 24, 2010, all animals will be moved into the barn for the show.

The Winter Social for all FFA and Booster Club members will be Tuesday, December 8, 2009. Hopefully we will have it in the Clear Brook Commons at 6:30 p.m. We will have a short club meeting, food, socializing and possible photo opportunities. Cheryl Hampton passed out a sign-up list, so parents could volunteer to bring side dishes, bread, and desserts. Cheryl volunteered to cook turkeys. Denise Christensen motioned to adjourn the meeting and Lori Burton seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 7:20p.m.
