

CLEAR BROOK FFA BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The following is an outline of the guidelines for awarding Booster Club Scholarships to Clear Brook FFA Seniors.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP

The following requirements must be met for a student to be eligible for a Clear Brook FFA Booster Club Scholarship:

1. Be a graduating senior who is entering a four-year college, junior college or technical school for the upcoming fall semester.
2. Applicant must be a paid member of the Clear Brook FFA and enrolled in an agriculture class during their senior year. His/her parent must be a paid Booster Club member.
3. The student must have no less than a "B" average in all agriculture science courses during high school, up to and including their senior year.
4. The student must be in the upper 2/3 of their graduating class, with satisfactory conduct.
5. The student must have applied for and met the entry requirements of the college or technical school they plan to attend.
6. The applicant must have participated in at least three FFA activities per semester for at least four semesters.

BASIS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

The basis for awarding scholarships is on academic achievement and participation in FFA activities.

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

The scholarship committee hereinafter called "committee" shall be appointed each year at a Clear Brook FFA Booster Club meeting by the booster club officers. The committee shall consist of four Booster Club members.

The committee members will elect a chairperson. No one shall serve as a chairperson or as a member who has a son or daughter that might be a potential scholarship applicant. The chairperson will be responsible for calling the meetings of the committee.

DESCRIPTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship winners will be determined by the committee. Up to \$2500 in total scholarships in variable amounts will be awarded, based on a points system.

PROCEDURE OF APPLYING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship applications will be distributed to the Ag-Science instructors by the committee chairperson. Ag-Science instructors will distribute the applications to the

Clear Brook FFA Seniors. The committee will make the final selection of scholarship winners.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

The winner(s) will be awarded the scholarship(s) at the annual Clear Brook FFA Parent/Member Banquet. A letter providing instructions on how to secure the scholarship award will be given to the selected seniors at the banquet.

AWARDING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

A check for the scholarship(s) will be issued to the student by the current Booster Club Treasurer under the following conditions:

Recipients will be required to contact the current FFA advisor with proof of enrollment/payment of college tuition.

The FFA advisor will notify the current Booster Club Treasurer and the Treasurer will issue a check to the recipient.

Scholarship recipients have until January 31st of the following year to claim their scholarship award.
